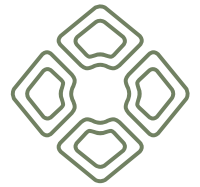


# Roses 2026



## Hybrid Tea Roses

Hybrid Tea roses have been the most recognisable class of rose for over a hundred years. They bare classic full flowers either singly or several to a stem. Many have a good fragrance and are excellent for cut flowers. Height ranges from 1m to 2m but averages 1.5m. Plant 1m apart.



### ASHRAM

Strong growing with bright old gold colouring flowers freely. Shining dark green foliage has excellent disease resistance. The large, full blooms are suitable for picking. Slight fragrance. 1.2m tall.



### ATOMIC BLONDE

This beautiful white rose has shapely high pointed buds on long stems making it a great cut flower with a slight fragrance. 1.5m tall.



### BELLE PARFUME

Double flower starts out a lovely pink to mauve colour but ages to pure mauve. Full and stunning flower, as the name suggests - has a strong and seductive fragrance that will appeal to all.



### BEST FRIEND

Vibrant blooms of deep, hot pink accompanied by a strong sweet perfume. Large, light green leaves and excellent health. Named by the RSPCA to celebrate 4 legged friends.



### BEWITCHED

Clear pink, often with a hint of salmon with glossy green foliage. The high-centred and very long lasting flowers have a strong fragrance. Repeat flowering.



### BLACK BEAUTY

Distinctive velvet red with an inclination toward black and a yellowish reverse. This rose is one of our blackest roses. A very productive cut flower variety with a good vase life. 1.2m tall.



### BLUE MOON

Large lavender blue blooms with strong fragrance on long slender stems. Healthy medium growth. Most popular of all the 'Blue Roses'.



### CAMP DAVID

A beautifully scented well formed dark red that is very resistant to adverse weather. The plant is extremely sturdy with healthy growth.



### CANDY CANE

Glossy green foliage provides a lovely background for the striking brightness of this rose. Red blooms with a white reverse grow on nice long stems. A strong tea fragrance.



### CHARLES DE GAULLE

Clear lilac blue accompanied by lovely fragrance in the form of fully double flowers. The plant is of low to medium height with healthy growth. One of the best mauves and a true delight.



### CHILD'S LOVE

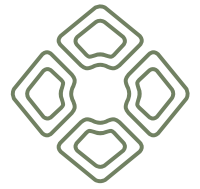
Beautiful frilly, scalloped petals in a gorgeous salmon-pink colour to match, plus a delightful strong fragrance - this rose is sure to attract attention! Abundance blooms, up to 1.2m.



### DARK DESIRE

From buds that are almost black, the cupped flowers emerge with a unique violet-red before maturing into a violet purple. Sophisticated fragrance of floral and fruity aspects. Height to 1.2m.

## Hybrid Tea Roses

### DOUBLE DELIGHT

Large double blooms of white to cream with heavily flushed and edged carmine to red. Bushes are of medium size, vigorous and of good health, with long strong stems. Strong fragrance.



### EKSTASE

Highly fragrant cut flower variety. The red blooms are produced with either one to each stem or several to a stem. Plant habit is strong, with healthy dark green foliage.



### FATHER'S LOVE

Dark velvety red, fully petalled blooms with a lasting fragrance of spice. Deep green foliage. Named in support of Australia's Centre for Men's Health.



### FRAGRANT PLUM

A deep lilac rose, edged rich purple, with a high centre. Strong perfume.



### GRANDMA'S ROSE

Repeat bloomer with dusky pink blooms with russet tones and all the romantic characteristics of old world roses combined with the tolerance we have grown to expect from our modern day hybrids.



### GRANDPA'S ROSE

Stunning scarlet crimson blooms that hold their form and colour well. These roses have a slight fragrance and a long lasting bold colour.



### HAPPY ANNIVERSARY

An excellent rose for the garden and as a supply of cut flowers. The stunning deep orange flowers are produced on long, firm, upright stems and combined with a lovely fragrance, provide a lasting display.



### HEAVEN SCENT

An intense old damask rose fragrance accompanies large blooms sitting on long stems with few thorns. A desirable rose.



### HONEY DIJON

A unique warm golden brown. This novel colouring develops deeper shades in cooler climates and will appeal with a pleasant fruity fragrance. Abundant production of formal, double blooms.



### ISN'T SHE LOVELY

A true Hybrid Tea producing only single, full petalled blooms that last long in a vase. Around 1.5m tall with an upright and bushy habit. Excellent disease resistance and a pleasant fragrance.



### JOHN F KENNEDY

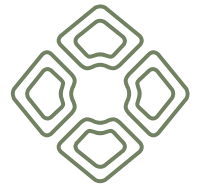
Highly fragrant, large pure white flowers on a tall shrub. This beautiful rose starts off with buds of a greenish tinge before slowly unfurling into flowers that can be as large as 5 inches across.



### JUST JOEY

Large decorative coppery orange to buff blooms with waved and frilled petals. Strong tough growth. The unique coloured flowers are sweetly scented. Rose Hall of Fame in 1994.

## Hybrid Tea Roses

### KARDINAL

A delightful bright red rose with beautifully formed medium-sized blooms produced in abundance. Blooms are rarely out of shape, and make for a beautiful, long lasting cut flower.



### LITTLE RAY OF SUNSHINE

Perfumed blooms of citrus and rose scents, on long stems. Airy, petal filled bloom of bright yellow, flowers continuously throughout the growing season. Grows to 1.5m tall. Name in support of the Australian Breastfeeding Association.



### LORRAINE LEE

An evergreen climber with long pointed buds that open to double, cupped blooms of coral pink. Rich green glossy foliage. Repeat flowering. Fragrant. Growth to 3m high and 2m wide.



### MONTEZUMA

Geranium red with mild fragrance. Large high centred t bloom form. Blooms in flushes throughout the season.



### MOON GLOW

Dreamy, full blooms of soft buttery gold hue to light up your garden night and day. With big and brilliant beams of gentle colour it is ideal for garden and pot alike. Superb disease resistance. 1.5m



### MOTHER'S LOVE

Soft, pale pink blooms gently deepen in colour toward the centre with a strong, sweet fragrance. Abundant deep green foliage on a healthy bush reaching 1.5m.



### MISTER LINCOLN

Classic dark velvety red blooms with a lovely fragrance in exhibition form. A strong healthy grower.



### NEPTUNE

Very fragrant, rich lavender bloom with a blush of purple on the outer edges. Abundant blooms amongst large glossy green leaves. 1.4m tall.



### NEW PAPA MEILLAND

An updated favourite – more resistant and more floriferous, with velvety red and a powerful fragrance mixing accents of geranium, carnation and white peach.



### OKLAHOMA

A very dark red rose with large double blooms of 45 to 55 petals. Flowers are produced on long stems and are very fragrant. A vigorous plant with lovely dark green foliage.



### PAPA MEILLAND

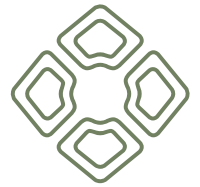
Prized for its dark velvet red, exhibition blooms that have a deep, heavy fragrance. An upright, vigorous bush to 1.2m. A good and very popular rose. Inducted into the Rose Hall of Fame in 1988.



### PAROLE

The largest bloom that we know of any hybrid tea. The plant is strong, healthy and vigorous. The huge dark pink bloom is highly fragrant. Intoxicating scent that develops over time.

## Hybrid Tea Roses

### PEACE

The large exhibition blooms of yellow, flushed pink have a pleasant fragrance. Very popular of all roses and was the first rose inducted into the Rose Hall of Fame in 1976. Makes an excellent standard.



### PERFUME DELIGHT

Large well formed blooms of deep pink with purplish tones. Lighter on the petal reverse with a spicy fragrance.



### PERFUME PASSION

Beautiful pink blooms are produced in abundance on long, almost thornless stems, and are enhanced by the deliciously strong fragrance. This disease free, strong bush will reach 1.5m tall x 60cm wide.



### POPE JOHN PAUL II

Producing luminous, pristine, lavishly petalled blossoms, this elegant rose grows in the Vatican's private garden. It has won trophies for fragrance, vigour, and superior disease resistance.



### REMEMBER ME

Extremely strong healthy dense foliage of medium tall habit. The blooms are a blend of fawn, cream, yellow and salmon, deepening in hot weather. Very unique.



### SO IN LOVE

Modern, highly floriferous rose celebrated for its masses of medium-sized, double blooms in a striking mix of soft lavender-pink with warm tawny or coppery undertones.



### SWEET SUSIE

Valued for its soft blush pink blooms that open from elegant pointed buds into fully double, cupped flowers. The blooms are carried in generous clusters, creating a romantic display.



### TEQUILA SUNRISE

A many petalled rose with blooms of yellow heavily flushed red. A very showy and bright rose of good health and vigour. This rose has won many awards including 3 Gold Medals.



### THE WEDDING ROSE

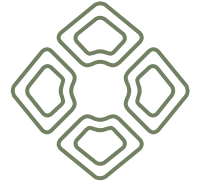
Refined rose, chosen for its large, soft romantic colouring and timeless elegance. The blooms are gently formed, opening into full flowers of soft blush pink with delicate subtle, tonal variation.



### UNCONDITIONAL LOVE

With all over medium Pink large pointed buds, unfolding to form beautiful spiral shaped flowers with a silvery reverse and a lush dark green foliage.

## Floribunda Bush

Second only to the hybrid tea in popularity, Floribunda roses bear flowers in large clusters, providing massive, colourful, long-lasting garden displays. As a class, they are hardier and easier to care for than their hybrid tea counterparts. They range from low growing varieties of 50cm high, but average at 1.2m. Well suited for use en masse, in pots or to form attractive borders and low hedges. Plant 50cm – 1m apart.



### ABOUT FACE

Striking and distinctive, admired for its dramatic two-tone colouring and strong garden performance. Opening in rich golden-orange tones with a deeper bronze-red reverse.



### ALFRED SISLEY

Magnificent colour swirls of burnt tangerine with splashes of creamy white. Hardy and disease resistant rose. Excellent repeat flowering,



### APRICOT NECTAR

Buff apricot flowers are quite large, fully petalled and have a pleasant fragrance. Ideal for floral arranging.



### BLUE EMOTION

Large highly attractive lilac-mauve blooms, with well-shaped bearing scalloped petals. Strong full double flowers are wonderfully fragrant.



### BLUE FOR YOU

Semi-double flowers that begin as rich purple mauve, fading to a striking slate blue. A healthy, free flowering plant that blooms over a long period. Strong scent, reminiscent of violets.



### BONICA

Shrub-type rose with masses of soft pink double blooms. Easy to grow, disease resistant and flowers continuously. Ideal for a low hedge or mass plantings.



### BURGUNDY ICEBERG

A burgundy sport of the loeberg. The plant is exactly like its parent in every way but colour. Same great landscape value, free flowering habit, foliage and the same great flowers.



### CARMAGNOLE

Stunning bi-colour, soft and feminine rose with clusters of ruffled ivory white blooms tipped with crimson, fading to soft pink as the flower ages. Lightly fragrant, and free flowering shrub rose.



### CHERRY BONICA

Attractive, compact shrub rose producing continuous trusses of luminous petal filled, cherry red blooms from late spring to late autumn. Hardy and highly disease resistant. Approximately 1.2 - 1.4m.



### CITY OF ADELAIDE

Clusters of semi-double, salmon pink blooms with a slight fragrance adorn this deep green, glossy bush. Ideal as a feature plant or grown as part of a massed bed. Up to 1.2m tall and 1.0m wide.



### COCONUT ICE

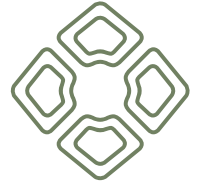
Musk pink with a soft white on the reverse of each petal in an Old English form. Neat, upright bush grows to 1.2m producing firm stems that hold clusters full blooms that have a mild fragrance.



### DUSKY MOON

Australian Bred rose. Cupped blooms in a lovely dusky- mauve with a white reverse enhanced by a strong fragrance, cover arching canes on a tall bush up to 1.3m.

## Floribunda Bush

Second only to the hybrid tea in popularity, Floribunda roses bear flowers in large clusters, providing massive, colourful, long-lasting garden displays. As a class, they are hardier and easier to care for than their hybrid tea counterparts. They range from low growing varieties of 50cm high, but average at 1.2m. Well suited for use en masse, in pots or to form attractive borders and low hedges. Plant 50cm – 1m apart.



### EBB TIDE

Deep purple, almost black buds open to reveal a very double, medium size old fashioned blooms of velvet purple that carry with them an intense clove fragrance. Just over 1m tall.



### ESPRESSO

Modern rose with a difference. Coffee brown, semi double petals with a bright yellow centre. Extremely healthy foliage with an upright growth. Make a statement with this interesting rose.



### EUROPEANA

Huge heads with camellia shape blooms. Very vigorous bush with dark foliage. Mild fragrance. Height 60 to 90cm. Blooms in flushes throughout the season. Heat tolerant.



### FAIRYTALE MAGIC

Fully petaled, light pink blooms with an apricot center and an enchanting fragrance sit on an extremely healthy upright bush to 90cm tall.



### FOR YOUR EYES ONLY

A standout in the Chris Warner series. Crossed with Hulthemia Persica, this new style rose is certainly spectacular. Large single blooms cover this lovely bush growing is approximately 1m high.



### GIFT OF FRIENDSHIP

Fully double flowers in a fresh fruity cherry red are produced continuously on a background of healthy dark green foliage. Neat trouble free growth to 70cm. Ideal for classic rose beds or pots.



### GOLD BUNNY

The soft gold blooms are fairly large and of classic shape. They are borne almost continuously on a compact light green bush up to 80 cm high, single or in small clusters on medium stems.



### HOMAGE TO BARBARA

Unusual double bloom rose in the most intense blood-red which ages to a deeper red, almost black colouring. The delicate curving fluted petals are velvety to touch and belie their toughness.



### ICE PRINCESS

'Bee friendly' rose with large open cupped blooms in off white with sun kissed pink edging. Subtle fragrance. Perfect for pots and borders, small hedges or garden. 1m x 50-80cm.



### KETCHUP & MUSTARD

Slap the brightest red onto a base of darkest yellow and set it atop the greenest, glossiest leaves and you get this well-behaved rounded rose.



### LEONARDO DA VINCI

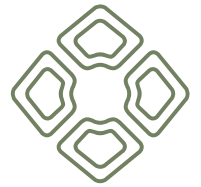
The very double, perfectly formed, rosette shaped blooms of 75 petals are in the style of English Roses. Rich pink flowers are produced in clusters and have a mild fragrance. Excellent repeat flowering.



### MAKE A WISH

Named for the Make-A-Wish Foundation. Clothed in clusters of cream to white blooms with a soft apricot centre. Blooms have a light sweet fragrance and sit amongst dark green, glossy foliage to 1m tall.

## Floribunda Bush

### NOVALIS

Fragrant lavender blooms, which take on an old world form, are produced abundantly, creating an incredible display on an easy care bush with light green leaves.



### ORANGES AND LEMONS

flamboyant rose that has vibrant double yellows blooms with orange splashes and stripes. New foliage begins a deep burgundy shade then matures to a deep green. Vigorous and hardy.



### ORIGAMI

The strongly angular red and white petals give the bloom a 'square' appearance. Highly disease resistant and well clothed in mid-green foliage. Light rose perfume.



### PAUL CEZANNE

Large double flowers with crinkly edges, of dusty yellows, with splashes of pink and touches of white. Each bloom features its own unique pattern.



### PLAYBOY

This burnt orange with yellow centred rose is very unique and it really stands out because the colours are just so different than any other. A very hardy and attractive rose.



### PUMPKIN PATCH

Unique colour – its rich copper buds open into clusters of beautiful orange flowers. Growing on an upright bush with shiny green leaves, this is a rose that will always bring joy.



### SCARLET BONICA

Produces masses and masses of vivid scarlet red flower clusters in a continuous colour halo. Each bright bloom shines and shimmers against the thick deep glossy green foliage.



### SEDUCTION

Medium large semi-double blooms. Pink, edges paling to cream, buff yellow centres. Clusters to 10 blooms. Very free long lasting cut flowers.



### SEXY REXY

Fully double, pink flowers are produced continuously in large clusters. An easily maintained compact, disease resistant bush.



### SOUL SISTER

Milky chocolate buds opening to latte coffee and ending in soulful lavender. A very elegant and unusual flower sitting on a healthy rounded bush with a light tea fragrance. 1.5m high.



### STAR BURST

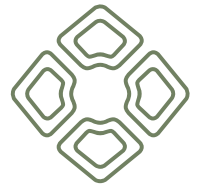
Spectacular display of splashed colour. First the bloom starts as a yellow cream base to soft pink edge splashed with deep pink/red turning to a white base in the open bloom.



### THE GOLDEN CHILD

Large bright yellow blooms are produced in clusters on a healthy bush coated in mid green leaves. Added to this lovely plant is a pleasing moderate fragrance.

## Floribunda Bush

### THE KARNIVAL

Pink blend roses bloom in large clusters. None to mild fragrance. Blooms in flushes throughout the season.



### TWILIGHT ZONE

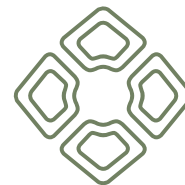
Amethyst purple blooms on a strong plant of deep green almost quilted leaves. Big fat buds open to very double old fashioned blooms with a strong clove and lemon citrus fragrance.



### WHITE ICEBERG

Nicely shaped pure white blooms cover the plant all season. Growth up to 5 metres but not overly rampant. Continually in bloom. Fragrant.

## David Austin

David Austin Roses ( English roses ) possess a unique charm with their beautiful full petalled, fragrant blooms and attractive shrubby appearance. These Modern Shrubs are versatile. Excellent for mixed borders and fit into any style garden. They can be cut for vases as a tight bud to open inside releasing a wide range of fragrances. The taller varieties make excellent short climbers.



### ABRAHAM DARBY

Large shrub with many-petalled flowers of apricot to yellow. Strong and disease resistant. Fragrant. 1.5m tall. Good as a cut flower.



### BOSCOBEL

Perfectly formed, beautifully fragrant, upward facing blooms. Rich salmon pink with peach highlights and myrrh fragrance with hints of elderflower, pear and almond. To 1m and repeat flowering.



### EMILY BRONTE

Beautiful rose with neat flat blooms with a button centre. Starts as a lovely soft pink with apricot central petals and fade to a creamy white. Strong tea scent with delicious hints of lemon and grapefruit.



### HERITAGE

Flowers are medium-sized, prettily cupped in shape and of a soft pink colour. Flowers repeatedly and regularly with a strong fragrance. Growth, relaxed at first, soon builds into a good bushy shrub.



### MARY ROSE

The mid pink flowers are of an attractive, loose-petalled formation and have an Old Rose scent with delicious hints of honey and almond blossom. It forms a well-shaped, bushy shrub.



### MUNSTEAD WOOD

Large, velvety crimson blooms in the distinctive English style. Strong Old Rose fragrance. Medium size bush with good disease resistance. About 1m - 1.2m tall.



### OLIVIA ROSE

Commences flowering very early in the season and continues well into Autumn. Medium to large fully cupped rosettes of an even mid pink, have a good fruity fragrance.



### QUEEN OF SWEDEN

Beautiful English Shrub rose with delicate blooms beginning as soft apricot-pink and gradually maturing to a pure soft pink and a captivating myrrh fragrance.



### ROALD DAHL

Soft orange-red buds open to medium-sized, cupped rosettes of perfect apricot colouring. They are extremely robust and have a lovely fruity Tea scent.



### SOPHY'S ROSE

Bears crimson-pink, rosette-shaped flowers; the petals are small at the centre and increase in size, by degrees, until the outer petals are quite large, resulting in broad, rather flat blooms.



### THE ANCIENT MARINER

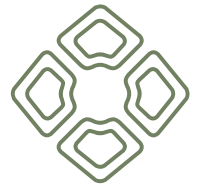
Bearing masses of large, many petalled blooms on a bushy, quite upright shrub. The blooms are a lovely glowing mid pink at the centre, paling towards the edges.



### THE MILL ON THE FLOSS

Large cupped blooms of rich yellow which pale. The fully double blooms contain a wonderful fruity fragrance with hints of lemon. Low rounded shrub to 1.2m. Approx 1m tall x 1m wide.

## David Austin

David Austin Roses ( English roses ) possess a unique charm with their beautiful full petalled, fragrant blooms and attractive shrubby appearance. These Modern Shrubs are versatile. Excellent for mixed borders and fit into any style garden. They can be cut for vases as a tight bud to open inside releasing a wide range of fragrances. The taller varieties make excellent short climbers.



### THE POET'S WIFE

Large cupped blooms of rich yellow which pale. The fully double blooms contain a wonderful fruity fragrance with hints of lemon. Low rounded shrub to 1.2m. Approx 1m tall x 1m wide.



### TOTTERING BY GENTLY

Soft buttercup single blooms make a spectacular display en masse and give a musk fragrance. The bush is approx. 1.25m high with large, open sprays on a rounded, branching shrub. One for the bees.



### WINCHESTER CATHEDRAL

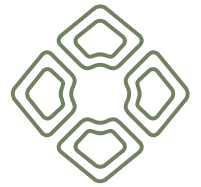
A sport of Mary Rose, this beautiful, fully double white rose carries a lovely fragrance, growing on a medium sized bush to 1.3m tall.



### WINDERMERE

Start as rounded buds, opening to full cupped flowers with over 80 petals. First a rich cream, fading to almost pure white in the sun. Delicious, fruity fragrance with a hint of citrus. 1m tall x 75cm.

## Smooth Touch Roses

All Smooth Touch® Thornless Rose varieties are considered 95-100% thorn free and therefore safer in gardens especially with children and elderly gardeners. Medium bushes producing clusters of flowers that open continuously from small buds. They are hardy vigorous long (repeat) flowering and disease resistant making them ideal plants to have in large pots or as hedges or borders.



### ANGEL

Treasured for its highly fragrant blooms in heavenly tones of apricot and cream, gently kissed with a soft pink blush on the outer petals. Classic shape and well-structured throughout its life.



### NONNA'S LOVE

Delicate, frilly pink petals subtly flushed and edged in rich carmine. Blooms stand out beautifully against glossy, dark green foliage, creating a striking contrast.



### RUBY RED

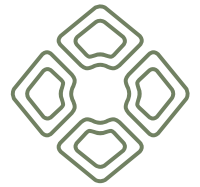
Deep, velvety red petals and enchanting sweet fragrance. Blooms contrast beautifully with glossy, deep green foliage and the rich bronze tones of new growth, creating a captivating display.



### SNOWFLAKE

Celebrated for its clusters of creamy white blooms with softly ruffled edges and a sweet, gentle fragrance. Flowering continuously throughout the warmer months, it brings a lasting sense of elegance.

## Climbing

Climbers can be used in a multitude of situations, limited only by your imagination. For best results, espalier the long canes into a horizontal position to promote lateral growth. Do not prune for the first two seasons and only to remove dead wood and unproductive growth. Allow time for the plants to establish themselves. Do not prune until the third or fourth season and try to leave the long canes.



### BLACK BOY

Large flowered semi-double blooms of dark crimson. Flowers are produced freely on a vigorous plant. Repeat flowering. Sweetly fragrant. Growth to approximately 4m spread.



### BLUE MOON

Large lavender blue blooms with strong fragrance on long slender stems. Healthy medium growth. Most popular of all the 'Blue Roses'.



### BLUSHING PIERRE

Beautiful old fashioned creamy white to pink flowers bloom constantly and carry a mild classic rose scent. The abundant foliage is lush, glossy deep green and healthy. 3m x 2m.



### BUFF BEAUTY

Lovely large, fully double apricot blooms fade to white on a beautiful Hybrid Musk bush. A vigorous grower with mid green leaves can be used as a shrub or climber. Strong Tea fragrance.



### FUTURE

Large fully petaled bloom in a clear white, sun kissed with pale pink has a nostalgic form and good health. Growth is between 2 and 2.5m spread on average.



### GOLD BUNNY

Ruffled, golden yellow blooms held in large clusters shine against the distinctive deep green foliage. Repeat flowering. 3m tall.



### HARMONIZE

Masses of beautiful cream open blooms with pink blushes and the tell-tale Persica Hybrid eye in red. Blooms will fade to an attractive blush white.



### JUST JOEY

A sport of the ever popular Just Joey. Large decorative coppery orange to buff blooms with waved and frilled petals. Strong tough growth. The unique coloured flowers are sweetly scented.



### KARDINAL

A delightful bright red rose with beautifully formed medium-sized blooms produced in abundance. Blooms are rarely out of shape, and make for a beautiful, long lasting cut flower.



### MOONLIGHT

### PIERRE GOLDEN

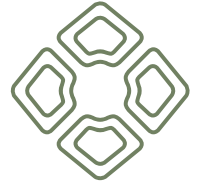
Hardy and healthy climber with bright light gold blooms. It is a great addition to the 'Pierre de Ronsard'® family of climbing roses and produces heritage style flowers almost continuously.



### PIERRE DE RONSARD

White to pale pink blooms deepening to carmine in the centre. Flowers freely and repeatedly. Fragrant. Ideal as a Pillar Rose. Inducted into the Rose Hall of Fame 2006. Approximately 2.5m spread.

# Roses 2026



## Climbing

Climbers can be used in a multitude of situations, limited only by your imagination. For best results, espalier the long canes into a horizontal position to promote lateral growth. Do not prune for the first two seasons and only to remove dead wood and unproductive growth. Allow time for the plants to establish themselves. Do not prune until the third or fourth season and try to leave the long canes.



### PIERRE RED

This climber produces masses of large, burgundy red, very double, cupped blooms with that 'old world' charm and elegance. Lightly fragrant. Healthy, lush, deep green foliage. Coverage 3m.



### PRIDE OF VENUS

Though a modern climber, it starts with formal Hybrid Tea shaped blooms, opening into fragrant old world shaped flowers which are reminiscent of a bygone era.



### QUICK SILVER

The rich mauve blooms are large and darken to the centre. Produced in clusters, they sit amongst deep green healthy foliage creating a striking display. Moderate sweet rose fragrance. Height 2.5m spread.



### TEASING GEORGIA

The centre petals are rich deep yellow, while the outer petals fall back and fade to palest yellow, providing a two-tone effect. Very strong, fragrant, graceful growth.



### THE HIGH LIFE

When espaliered, covers itself in large, loosely double, bright yellow blooms with a slight scent. The glossy, dark green foliage appears to resist disease very well.



### TRUE FRIEND

Admired for its long, pointed copper-pink buds that unfurl into cheerful copper-apricot blooms with subtly darker reverse petals. Each flower showcases classic Hybrid Tea form.



### WEDDING DAY

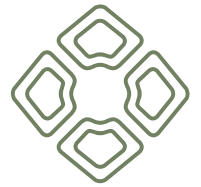
Huge clusters of apricot buds opening to single creamy-yellow flowers which quickly fade to white. Vigorous climber growing to 10 metres. Citrus fragrance.



### WHITE ICEBERG

Nicely shaped pure white blooms cover the plant all season. Growth up to 5 metres but not overly rampant. Continually in bloom. Fragrant.

# Roses 2026



## Patio Standard Roses

Patio standard roses, also referred to as stem roses, are grafted at a height of 60cm and are a variation of the normal bush rose. Ideal for adding height to a garden and can also create a formal appearance if planted in a row.

Plant approx. 1.0m apart.



### CAMP DAVID

A beautifully scented well formed dark red that is very resistant to adverse weather. The plant is extremely sturdy with healthy growth.



### EUROPEANA

Huge heads with camellia shape blooms. Very vigorous bush with dark foliage. Mild fragrance. Height 60 to 90cm. Blooms in flushes throughout the season. Heat tolerant.



### GOLD BUNNY (F)

The soft gold blooms are fairly large and of classic shape. They are borne almost continuously on a compact light green bush, single or in small clusters on medium stems.



### PEACE (HT)

The large exhibition blooms of yellow, flushed pink have a pleasant fragrance. Probably the most popular of all roses and was the first rose inducted into the Rose Hall of Fame in 1976.



### TEQUILA SUNRISE

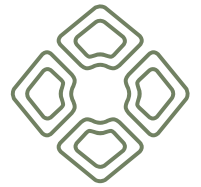
A many petalled rose with blooms of yellow heavily flushed red. A very showy and bright rose of good vigour. Height 80cm.



### WHITE ICEBERG

Nicely shaped pure white blooms cover the plant all season. Growth up to 5 metres but not overly rampant. Continually in bloom. Fragrant.

## 90cm Standard Roses

### AFTERNOON DELIGHT

Compact growth habit with clusters of large double flowers in soft apricot that changes to pink as the flowers age. With a sweet moderate fragrance and excellent disease resistance. 1m tall.



### BLACKBERRY NIP (HT)

This shapely magenta purple bloom comes on a long stem with a delicious fragrance. The blue-grey hue in its dark green foliage sets the plant off perfectly. 1.5m x 1m.



### BLUE MOON

Large lavender blue blooms with strong fragrance on long slender stems. Healthy medium growth. Most popular of all the 'Blue Roses'.



### BONICA

Shrub-type rose with masses of soft pink double blooms. Easy to grow, disease resistant and flowers continuously. Ideal for a low hedge or mass plantings.



### CHARLES DE GAULLE

Clear lilac blue accompanied by lovely fragrance in the form of fully double flowers. The plant is of low to medium height with healthy growth. One of the best mauves and a true delight.



### CHILD'S LOVE

Beautiful frilly, scalloped petals in a gorgeous salmon-pink colour to match, plus a delightful strong fragrance – this rose is sure to attract attention! Abundance blooms.



### DOUBLE DELIGHT (HT)

Large double blooms of white to cream. Heavily flushed and edged carmine to red. Bushes are of medium size, of good health and vigour with long strong stems. Strong fragrance.



### GOLD BUNNY (F)

The soft gold blooms are fairly large and of classic shape. They are borne almost continuously on a compact light green bush, single or in small clusters on medium stems.



### GOLDEN BEAUTY (F)

Gold in every sense! The glowing amber, high centred blooms are produced in large clusters on a compact bush of dark green leaves. A great performer in hot dry climates with fragrant blooms.



### HEAVEN SCENT (HT)

An intense old damask rose fragrance accompanies large blooms sitting on long stems with few thorns. A desirable rose.



### JUST JOEY (HT)

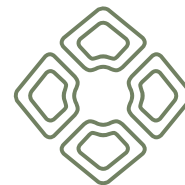
Large decorative coppery orange to buff blooms with waved and frilled petals. Strong tough growth. The unique coloured flowers are sweetly scented.



### MISTER LINCOLN (HT)

Classic dark velvety red blooms with a lovely fragrance in exhibition form. A strong healthy grower.

**POPE JOHN PAUL II (HT)**  
Producing luminous, pristine, lavishly petalled blossoms. This rose has won trophies and medals all around the world for fragrance, vigour and superior disease resistance.



**REMEMBER ME**  
Extremely strong healthy dense foliage of medium tall habit. The blooms are a blend of fawn, cream, yellow and salmon, deepening in hot weather. Very unique.



**WHITE ICEBERG**  
Nicely shaped pure white blooms cover the plant all season. Growth up to 5 metres but not overly rampant. Continually in bloom. Fragrant.
